

2023 Annual Rhode Island Residential Sewer User Charge Survey



The Narragansett Bay Commission would like to thank the communities that participated in this year's Residential Sewer User Charge Survey.

The results of the survey are shown in the table below. Please note that the annual residential sewer user charges are for a single-family home with water usage of 73.2 HCF (150 gpd). The average residential annual sewer user charge for participating Rhode Island cities and towns is \$719.
