



Here are some FOGs you might find in your kitchen.




Milk and Cream

Fog in the air clouds your vision, making it hard to see. FOGs clog up the pipes, making it hard for water to move.




Can you find all the FOGs in this fridge?




Here are some other things that you should never put in your toilets and drains.

Paint and Paint Thinners




Chemicals
