Dear Smithfield Residents:

The Town of Smithfield has partnered with WM to provide you with a comprehensive solid waste and recycling program designed to encourage recycling and waste reduction, reduce litter in our neighborhoods and ensure that all waste is disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner.

We look forward to servicing the residents of Smithfield and in helping your community continue to be as clean - and green - as possible.

The Town of Smithfield has implemented a Mandatory Recycling Policy!

What does this mean to the resident? Your trash will not be collected unless there are acceptable recyclable materials placed in your designated recycling cart and the cart remains curbside next to your designated trash cart until both carts have been emptied by WM.

TRASH & RECYCLING

Trash and Recycling will both be collected once per week. All materials must be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day.

To ensure proper collection, trash must be bagged and placed inside your green lid cart.

Please do not bag your recyclables, this material must be loose and placed inside your yellow lid recycling cart.

Cart lids MUST be closed completely

YARD WASTE

Yard waste must be set at the curb tied in bundles of branches that are under 3 inches in diameter and under 3 feet in length; in brown paper bags (available at local retailers) or barrels clearly labeled "YARD WASTE"

Yard waste in plastic bags, or boxes will not be collected. Yard Waste will be collected every week April through May, every other week June through October and every week in November through the third week in December. Please see the included service calendar for details.

COMPOSTING

Composting is a good way to reduce your curbside yard waste collection requirements. Compost bins are available for residents to purchase at the Smithfield Public Works Garage located at 3 Spragueville Road (behind Dave’s Towing Service) and Rhode Island Resource Recovery.



BULKY, LARGE METAL & APPLIANCE ITEMS

Bulk items are collected on designated Saturdays. Large Metal and appliance items (White Goods) are collected on designated Fridays. Both are collected by appointment ONLY.

These collections are limited and scheduled on a first come, first serve basis. There are two options for scheduling a pick-up request.

(1) Contact WM (800) 972-4545. Collection appointments must be called in before 11:00 a.m. the day before the collection.

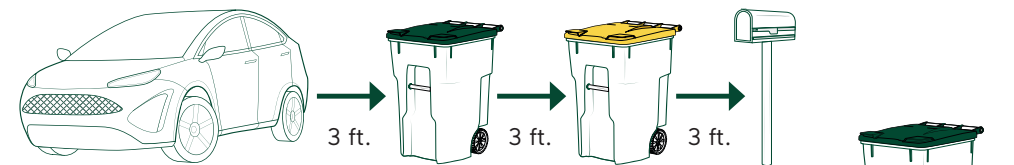

PROPER CART PLACEMENT

Place your cart at least 3 feet away from all objects, including your second cart, mailbox, car, or tree. The lid opening should face the street with the wheels of the cart facing your house.



All trash must be bagged and fit inside the cart with the lid firmly closed. Material outside of the cart will not be collected.



Have your carts at the curb the night before or **no later than 6 a.m.** on your collection day.
